In Memory of Shaheed Baba Deep Singh Ji

Baba Deep Singh Ji is one of the most honoured Martyrs in Sikh History. He was the founder of the Shaheedan misl and as well as of the Damdami Taksal (Damdama School of learning). He spent most of his life as a custodian of the Panth. Not only, was he a brave and fearless soldier but a very intelligent scholar also who had mastered several languages.

Baba Ji was born in 26th January, 1682. He was the son of Bhai Bhagata Ji and Mai Jeoni Ji a Sikh couple living in Pahuvind, Amritsar. Baba Ji's parents were hard working sikh farmers. He was named Deepa (light). From about 12 years of age, he grew up around the tenth Guru, Guru Gobind Singh Ji in Anandpur Shaib. He learnt Gurmukhi (Punjabi Script) and several other languages from Bhai Mani Singh Ji and other sikh scholars. It was here that he learnt the art of horsemanship, hunting and the use of the bow and other weapons. At the age of eighteen, he received Amrit from the Panj Pyare at Anandpur Shaib on Vaisakhi day and took an oath to serve as one of Waheguru Ji's warriors (Akal Purkh di fauj). With his new name, Deep Singh also learnt that Sikhs are meant to always help the weak and needy, and to fight for truth and justice.

Guru Gobind Singh Ji recited the entire Granth Sahib to Bhai Mani Singh Ji and Baba Deep Singh Ji while they wrote the text. Baba Deep Singh Ji wrote five more copies of the Holy Scriptures. Four copies were sent to Shri Akal Takht Sahib, Shri Takht Patna Sahib, Shri Takht Hazur Sahib And Shri Takht Anandpur Sahib. Another copy was prepared by Baba Deep Singh Ji in Arabic Script and sent to the Middle East.

In 1707, Baba Deep Singh Ji joined Banda Singh Bhadur to fight for the freedom of Punjab. They fought together in the battle at Sirhind, the city in which Guru Gobind Singh Ji's younger sons had been killed. During the

battle, Baba Deep Singh Ji beheaded Wazir Khan. Later, when the Sikh forces were reorganised into twelve Misls (group), Baba Deep Singh Ji was appointed In Charge of the Shaheedi division.

In 1755, when India was attacked by Ahmad Shah Abdali, the emperor of Afghanistan, Baba Deep Singh Ji and his men freed much of stolen goods and liberated the prisoners, returning them to their homes. Ahmad Shah Abdali was able to escape to Lahore. In 1757, Jahan Khan, his General, proceeded to Amritsar with heavy artillery. Many Sikhs died fighting to defend Shri Harimander Sahib but unfortunately the Gurudwara and its surrounding buildings were demolished and Sarovar was filled with dirt and debris. Shri Harimander Sahib was then closed to all Sikhs. Baba Deep Singh Ji took a vow not to come back alive, without freeing the Gurudwara from the Mughals.

Although Baba Deep Singh Ji was seventy-five years old, he still had the strength of young warriors. Baba Deep Singh Ji fought with his 18-ser Khanda (weighing about 32 lbs). During the clash, one of the Mogul commanders, Jamal Khan, attacked Baba Deep Singh Ji. As they fought, both men swung their weapons with great force, leaving both of their heads separated from their bodies. Baba Deep Singh Ji immediately stood up, holding his head on his left palm while holding his Khanda upright in his right hand and continued fighting till he reached Shri Harimander Sahib. He bowed his head at the prikarma (rectangular walkway) and lay there as a Martyr.

Baba Deep Singh Ji's Shaheedi incited the Sikhs to continue to fight against Mohgul oppression for many years. Even today, he is a symbol for all Sikhs how to live and die with dignity.

Historical Background of the Institution

Shaheed Baba Deep Singh Institute of Nursing is situated in Aherwan. District Fatehabad. It came into existence in 2006 and approved by Government Of Haryana, Recognized By Indian Nursing Council New Delhi And Haryana Nurses And Nurse Midwives Council Panchkula and Affiliated to Pt. B.D Sharma University Health Sciences, Rohtak.

At SBDS Institute of Nursing, the nursing discipline is nurtured by the mutual collaboration and co operation of the SBDS Welfare and Society. The College of Nursing was started functioning from July 2006 onwards and 1st batch for B.Sc, P.B.B.Sc, GNM and ANM courses were admitted in the academic year 2006-2007 and regular classes were started from September onwards.

SBDS institute of nursing has M.Sc Nursing with annual intake 31 seats, Post Basic B.Sc nursing with annual intake of 50 Seats, Basic B.Sc nursing with annual intake of 50 students where as General Nurse Midwife and Auxiliary Nurse Midwife with annual intake of 40 students and total Teaching faculty strength of our college is 39, out of which 16 are M.Sc Nursing with different specialty M.Sc in Obstetric and Gynecological Nursing, Medical Surgical Nursing, Child Health Nursing, Mental Health Nursing and Community Health Nursing.

An Equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or
University with science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English
with minimum of 50% aggregate marks (PCBE).

3. Candidate shall be medically fit.

1. Candidate should have passed GNM after 12th.
2. Candidate should be registered with State Nursing Council

M.Sc Nursing

1. Must have passed B. Sc nursing/Post Basic B. Sc nursing with minimum 55% aggregate marks from any indian nursing council recognized nursing college and in case of SC/ST/BC category candidates minimum 50% aggregate marks
2. Must be registered nurse and registered midwives or equivalent with any state nursing registration council
3. Must have minimum one year of work experience of recognized institute after B.Sc nursing/Post Basic B. Sc nursing. This work experience will be calculated from the date of registration in parent council till the last date of submission of form

1. Application forms can also be obtained personally from Admission Center of the College of Nursing.
2. The application form should be completed by the applicant in her/his own handwriting.
3. The duly filled in application form should reach the Admission Officer on time.
4. Full name of the Candidate as spelt in the SSLC records should be given in the application form with other related documents and snaps.
5. The information given in the application should be correct. False information or suppression of any factual information in the application would lead to disqualification/ or termination from the programme.
6. The Candidate should possess good health and character and free from physical and mental handicap.
7. Copies of all the certificates enclosed should be attested by the gazetted officer. Once submitted, the copies of the certificates will not be returned. Do not submit any original certificate with the application form.
8. Candidates applying for P.B.B.Sc. Nursing should produce a copy of the Indian Nursing Council Recognition of the College/ School of Nursing where she/ he has completed the qualifying examination.
9. The duly filled in application form should reach the Admission officer together with the following documents:
 - i. Attested true copies of the mark list of SSLC and pre University Examination or its equivalent.
 - ii. Attested copy of Birth Certificate/SSCL Certificate (first page of the SSLC Cumulative Record)
 - iii. Conduct Certificate from the head of the Institution last attended.

- iv. One duly attested passport size photograph to be fixed on the application form.
- v. Transfer Certificate.
- vi. Migration Certificate from the Board/ University.
- vii. Admissions are open for Girls and Boys.

NOTE:

Candidates called for Counseling should bring with them the certificate in original. All the certificate should bear the same name. If any change of name, it should be accompanied by an affidavit to this effect.

Note:

1. Anatomy and Physiology-Question paper will consist of section A Anatomy of 37 marks and B Physiology should be of 38 marks.

2. Nutrition and Biochemistry and Question paper will consist of section A Nutrition of 45 marks and section B of Biochemistry of 30 marks.
3. Pharmacology, Genetics, Pathology: Section a of Pharmacology with 38 marks, Section B of Pathology of 25 and Genetics with 12 marks.
4. Nursing Research and Statistics- Nursing Research should be of 50 marks and Statistics of 25 marks.
5. Minimum pass marks shall be 40% for English only.
6. Theory and practical Exam for Introduction to Computer to be conducted as College Exam and marks to be sent to the University for Inclusion in the mark sheet.
7. Minimum pass marks shall be 505 in each of the theory and practical papers separately.
8. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) on theory and practical in each subject for appearing for Examination.
9. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree.
10. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
11. If a candidate fails in either theory and practical paper he/she has to Re-appear for both the papers (theory and Practical)
12. Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
13. A candidate failing in more than two subjects will not be promoted to the next year.
14. Candidate shall not be admitted to the subsequent higher Examination unless the candidate has passed the previous Examination.

15. The maximum period of complete the course successfully should not exceed 20 per day.
16. Maximum no. of candidate for practical examination should not exceed 20 per day.
17. All practical Examinations must be held in the respective Clinical areas.
18. One internal and one external Examiner should jointly conduct practical examination for each student.
19. An examiner should be a lecturer or above in a College of Nursing with M.Sc. (N) in concerned subject and minimum of three years of teaching experience. To be an Examiner for nursing foundations course faculty having M.Sc. (N) with any specialty shall be considered.

2. General Nursing and Midwifery and Auxillary Nurse

Midwife

AIMS :

- i. To prepare Nurses with a sound educational programme in nursing to enable them to function as efficient members of the health team, beginning with the competencies for first level positions in all kinds of health care setting.
- ii. To help Nurses develop an ability to co-operate and co-ordinate with members of the health team in the prevention of disease, promotion of health and rehabilitation of the sick.
- iii. To help Nurses in their personal and professional development, So that they are able to make maximum contribution to the society as useful and productive individuals, citizens as well as efficient Nurses.

FUNDAMENTAL OF NURSING LAB.

The department undertakes training of nursing students. Students receive training in basic nursing procedures, which help them to provide basic care to patients. Students are given training in developing basic skills in the laboratory on simulated conditions before they are exposed to the actual hospital situation. The faculty of the department provides good teaching- learning exposure to the students.

COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING LAB

The Community Health Nursing Laboratory is designed for the students to develop skills in primary care for the individuals, families and groups at both urban & rural settings. It provides facilities for the students to practice skills related to Community Health Nursing.

MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH NURSING LAB.

College Rules and Regulations:

1. Campus Discipline
